Pet Walk Wisconsin Program



While we wait to gather together again, why not step outside with your pet and enjoy the natural beauty of Wisconsin — it's gorgeous in every season.

The Iowa County Humane Society is sponsoring a pet walk program to reward animal lovers for enjoying the outdoors throughout the year. Join us virtually by participating in this fundraiser for ICHS.

All registration fees will go toward care for the animals in need of Iowa County.

Program Guidelines

- ❖ ICHS PET WALK WISCONSIN is open to anyone, including non-Wisconsin residents.
 - ❖ Participation in the program is easy and based on hours spent walking your pet. The program provides equal opportunity for all participants regardless of speed.
 - ❖ Logging of hours begins the date the application and paid fees have been received at the Iowa County Humane Society office. Hours cannot be logged retrospectively.
 - ❖ Hours walked must be logged on an Iowa County Humane Society official program form.
 - ❖ Log sheets are available at ICHS.net. Additional copies may be printed by participants as needed.
 - ❖ Hours logged are for the individual, not the pet. Multiple pets can be walked, and participants do not need to own the animal.
 - ❖ The purpose of the program is to encourage and recognize individuals for getting out and walking. Hours may be accumulated any time participants walk anywhere in Wisconsin or out-of-state. Activity needs to be classified as recreational walking.
 - * Clarification: Hours may not include walking in a show arena, hunting or competition, either indoors or outdoors, schooling or training for any type of show. If in doubt contact the Program Coordinator listed below. *
 - ❖ ICHS PET WALK WISCONSIN is based on the honor system. No proof of hours is required. Any person knowingly falsifying information will automatically be disqualified. No refund of program fees will be issued and future enrollment requests will be denied
 - ❖ Completed log sheets should be submitted to the Iowa County Humane Society office by January 1 of the following year. Any log sheets received after January 31 of the following year will not qualify.
 - ❖ Hours are cumulative from year to year. Recognition will be given at the end of each year.
- BONUS HOURS!** –Add 50 bonus hours if your pet came from the Iowa County Humane Society and 30 if your pet came from another Humane Society or rescue program.

Awards: Recognition Certificates will be given at the end of each year. Names of participants may be used in various ICHS promotional materials. Pictures may also be featured when available.

Cost: ICHS Pet Walk Wisconsin fees are \$35 per year, per participant or family (family members 18 years and under). Registration automatically includes membership in ICHS.
